#### [1] SHCA releases Shanghai Copyright Industry Report (2006-2010)

[National Copyright Administration]

...The Shanghai Copyright Administration (SHCA) recently released the Shanghai Copyright Industry Report (2006-2010) which contains a comprehensive statistical analysis of Shanghai copyright industry development during the "11th Five-Year" plan period.

According to the report, from 2006 to 2010, Shanghai copyright industry development shows the following three characteristics: (1) the copyright industry's contribution to economy has become increasingly prominent. During the "11th Five-Year" plan period, the economic contribution rate of Shanghai copyright industry to Shanghai's GDP raised from 8.42% in 2006 to 14.36% in 2010, increased by 6 percentage points. The foreign trade in the copyright industry maintained surplus and the exports maintained more than three times the imports; (2) the leading role of the core copyright sectors has been improved significantly. The economic contribution rate of core copyright sectors, such as publication and distribution, radio, film and television, culture and arts, computer services, to Shanghai's GDP grew from 4.09% to 12.64% within five years; (3) the dominance of Shanghai copyright industry was more obvious. From the perspectives of the proportion of copyright industry and core copyright sectors' added value to GDP and industrial contribution rate to employment, the data in Shanghai is higher than the national data. In addition, the gap between Shanghai copyright industry and the U.S. copyright industry is narrowing.

### **[1] Ruling made on Huawei-ZTE patent case in Europe**

[State Intellectual Property Office]

...On March 28, in regard to the case in which Huawei Technologies Co., Ltd. (Huawei) sued ZTE Corporation (ZTE) for infringing upon the patent for EP724 rotor head data card, the Paris District Court rejected all of Huawei's claims and ordered the plaintiff Huawei to pay EUR 100,000 in damages to the defendant ZTE and its subsidiary in France.

### **[1] Grass-roots courts to govern first-instance patent cases upon authorization**

[Supreme People's Court]

...The Decision of the Supreme People's Court on Revising the "Certain Provisions of the Supreme People's Court on Issues Concerning Application of Law in Trying Cases Involving Patent Disputes" was promulgated on April 14, 2013 and came into effect on April 15. Under the revised judicial interpretations, the Supreme People's Court may, depending on actual circumstances, designate grass-roots people's courts to exercise jurisdiction over first-instance cases of patent disputes.
