[National Copyright Administration of China]

...On Jul 8, 2015, the National Copyright Administration of China (NCAC) issued a notice that, as from Jul 2015, it would launch a special online music copyright campaign to reinforce copyright regulation of online music service providers. In view of the widespread phenomenon of unauthorized dissemination of music works online by music service providers, they are ordered to stop unauthorized dissemination of music works forthwith, and remove all unauthorized music contents by Jul 31, 2015.

Online music service providers that continue to disseminate unauthorized music works after Jul 31, 2015 will be severely punished by the NCAC according to law.

...The "Net Sword 2015" special campaign targeting at internet piracy was launched on Jun 10. The campaign in 2015 prioritizes "a crackdown on copyright infringement in Cloud storage services". It is reported that 5 key tasks has been set out for "Net Sword 2015": special rectification of online music

copyright regulation; special rectification of copyright regulation in Cloud storage services; cracking down on App related piracy activities, standardizing the use of copyrights among App developers and sellers; special rectification concerning online advertising alliances; further standardizing copyright reprinting businesses conducted on the internet, strengthening content copyright protection in digital publishing, reinforcing copyright regulation of internet media businesses, clamping down on piracy activities, e.g. unauthorized reproduction or transmission of others' works, safeguarding and promoting harmonious development of the traditional publishing industry and the new media.
