<Indonesia> Warning of Trademark “OREO”

Kraft Foods Global Brands LLC, as the holder of well-known trademark “OREO” in Class 30, lately founds products of biscuits and other cakes that are sold in the market using trademark that has similarity with or imitate trademark “OREO”. Hereby, Kraft Foods Global Brands LLC warns any parties to stop the trademark infringement or will be sued at court.

<Indonesia> Orion Lost in Trademark Case

Judges at Commercial Court of Central Jakarta refuse to cancel trademark “Orion” in the name of Purwohadi Santoso (Defendant). In addition, in counter claim, judges agree to cancel trademark “Orion” in the name of Orion Corporation (plaintiff) because it has similarity in its essential part with trademark “Orion” in the name of defendant that has been previously registered. Defendant’s trademark has been registered in 1974 while plaintiff’s trademark has been registered in 1994.

<Indonesia> Forever Inc Won the Trademark Case

Yesterday (21/11), judges at Commercial Court of Central Jakarta agree to cancel trademark “Forever 21” No. IDM000007120 in Class 25 (all kind of clothing) in the name of Sudarno Hartono (defendant) because it has similarity in its entirety or in its essential part with well-known trademarks “Forever 21” No. IDM000282204 Cl. 35 (services: selling of clothing etc.) and No. IDM000237844 Cl 25 (goods: scarf, hat) owned by Forever Inc., (plaintiff). Meanwhile, defendant states they will submit appeal to Supreme Court.

<Indonesia> DGIP Will Recruit More Investigator
