Head of Formality Examination of Mark Office, Saky Septiono, states that until January 2013, there are 14 Indonesian products which had obtained geographical indication certificate. They are Kopi Arabika Kintamani (Bali), Mebel Ukir Jepara (Jepara), Lada Putih Munthok (Bangka Belitung), Kopi Arabika Gayo (Aceh), Tembakau Hitam Sumedang (Sumedang), Tembakau Mole Sumedang (Sumedang), Susu Kuda Sumbawa (NTB), Kangkung Lombok (NTB), Beras Adan Krayan (Kalimantan Timur), Kopi Arabika Flores Bajawa (NTT), Vanille Kep. Alor (NTT), Purwaceng Dieng (Central Java), and Carica Dieng (Central Java).

Marino Orlandi/Director of Pelletteria Orlandi Marino (plaintiff) files a lawsuit at Commercial Court of Central Jakarta to cancel registration of trademark "Marino Orlandi and Logo" No. IDM000127394 (Class 18), IDM000124904 (Class 25), IDM000254760 (Class 18), IDM000214143 (Class 25), in the name of Hasan Ibrahim because the trademarks were filed with having bad faith

because it imitate the well-known trademarks owned by plaintiff.

<Indonesia> IIPA Asks USTR to Keep Indonesia in Priority Watch List

International Intellectual Property Alliance (IIPA) makes a recommendation to United State Trade Representative (USTR) so that Indonesia remains in the Priority Watch List for 2013. In addition to Indonesia, 6 other countries: Argentine, Chili, China, Costa Rica, India and Russia are also recommended to be listed. According to IIPA, the recommendation is resulted from evaluation of the obedience of a country regarding IP enforcement and protection.
